Release of Short Term Capacity for the 2020/21 Year

Supplementary Notice to Important Notice, Application for Short Term Capacity for the 2020/21 Year dated 5 June 2020.

In accordance with 3.12(c) of Port Loading Protocols, please find information below regarding Quarters whereby the proportion of Short Term Capacity offered at a particular Port Terminal varied from the amount offered at that Port Terminal in the corresponding Quarter of the previous Year by more than 10%.

Q2 Port Giles

23% increase in Short Term Capacity offered (additional 15,000mt) compared to 2019/20.

The increase of capacity offered across the Quarter results in greater consistency of tonnes offered per shipping window at Port Giles terminal. This creates an opportunity for further shipping from the terminal. The increase also minimises the need for participants to execute a vessel across multiple shipping windows which would result in de-prioritisation.

Q3 Wallaroo

38% increase in Short Term Capacity offered (additional 15,000mt) compared to 2019/20.

The increase of capacity offered in selected shipping windows better aligns with port usage to load a Handymax vessel to maximum or part load a Panamax vessel. The increase also minimises the need for participants to execute a vessel across multiple shipping windows which would result in de-prioritisation.
